LESSON 10:

Joshua vs. The Wall

Bible Summary

Joshua 5:13–6:27

In today's lesson, the children will learn how God helped Joshua. God asked Joshua to lead the people. When Joshua and the Israelites obeyed by marching around the city of Jericho and blowing their trumpets, the walls came tumbling down. God was on Joshua and the Israelites' side.

PEOPLE NEEDED:

Teacher, Queen Henrietta, Joshua, Sound Volunteer

SUPPLIES AND VISUALS:

- *The Beginner's Bible*
- Royal presentation tray
- Bell
- Bag or backpack
- Toy trumpet or horn (placed inside bag)
- Several large boxes (packing boxes of the same size work best)
- Royal game box

EQUIPMENT NEEDED:

- CD Player
- Fall Quarter Sound Effects CD #2
- Music CDs

COSTUME NEEDED:

- 2 Robes

IN ADVANCE:

- Recruit people needed. Make sure a Teacher or other volunteer is prepared to lead the music and that someone is ready to operate the music and sound effects CDs. If your teaching area has stage lighting or a dimmer switch on the lights, ask a Small Group Leader to be prepared to dim the lights at "night" and bring them back up when it's "day" during the teaching about Joshua marching around the wall of Jericho.
- Print and copy the three child pictures (*Lesson 10 LG 2—Lesson 10 LG 4*) and place them in the royal game box. Make sure the images are large enough for all the children to see. (See Unit Overview for sizing tips.)
- Stack boxes as a "wall" at the side of the teaching area. The wall should be approximately as tall as the Teacher.
- Gather the rest of your props and set the teaching area.
- Print out the script and rehearse the teaching time.
