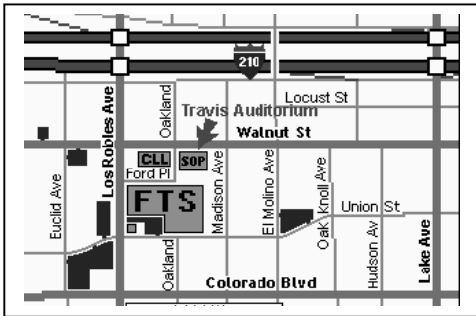
Directions to Where You Want to Be

From Los Angeles: Take the 110 Freeway North, Exit on Fair Oaks Ave. in South Pasadena; Go North on Fair Oaks Ave., turn right (East) on Walnut Ave.; see below for parking instructions.

From the 210 Freeway: Exit at Lake Avenue, go South on Lake Ave. to Walnut Avenue (2 blocks); Turn right (West) on Walnut and proceed to N. Oakland Ave.; see below for parking instructions.

Public parking is located at the corner of Union and Los Robles, and North Oakland and Colorado. Fuller is not able to provide visitor parking on Thursday and Friday due to student needs. However, on Saturday all lots will be open for visitors. Fuller does not recommend street parking, as cars parked longer than two hours will be ticketed by the City of Pasadena.
