Directions to Where You Want to Be

From the 405 South Freeway: Take 405 S FWY and exit CA-73 S toward 55 S FWY. Merge onto 55 S FWY. Exit Victoria Blvd. onto Newport Blvd. Go through the light at Victoria and turn right into The Crossing's parking structure.

From John Wayne Airport (SNA): Takes approximately 10 minutes. Head towards airport exit and bear right onto Airport Way toward Ticketing/Check In/Valet Parking – go 1 mile. Turn right on Campus Drive – go 1 mile. Turn right on Bristol Street going north. Take left ramp onto CA-73 N towards CA-55 N/I-405 N – go .6 mile. Take exit #17B/CA-55 onto CA-55 S – go 2 miles. Take exit #3/22nd St/Victoria St onto Newport Blvd – go .5 mile. Turn right into The Crossing's parking structure.
